CRYPTO SCAM

Pennsylvania Attorney General **Dave Sunday** is warning of a rise in scams involving Bitcoin ATMs. Scammers use Bitcoin ATMs to gain access to a victim's money by convincing them to make a large cash withdrawal, which is then deposited into a Bitcoin ATM. The victim then sends a QR code to the scammer, giving them access to the funds. To avoid being scammed, Sunday is advising people to avoid clicking unknown links or responding to unexpected calls and messages. Here is a **list** of known Bitcoin ATMs in Pennsylvania. Who knew they were so popular!

THE REPLACEMENT

Shortly thereafter former Democratic Commissioner *Matt McGloin* announced his resignation, Commissioner *Bill Gaughan* selected *Max Conway* to potentially fill the vacant Commissioner seat. SOUNDS FISHY

The PA Fish and Boat Commission needs volunteers to stock trout in lakes across the Commonwealth. According to the Commission, there are 3.2 million trout set to be stocked in the next few weeks. Stocking season begins on March 1 and will run until the fishing season begins on April 5. *Grab your waders!*

A new program is being offered to homeowners in Pennsylvania to remove invasive trees.
