

Pennsylvania Attorney General **Dave Sunday** is warning Pennsylvanians to be vigilant for potential romance scams ahead of Valentine's Day. In a statement, Sunday said, "Be aware of scammers who use the holiday to target single people in chat rooms and other online platforms. Online scammers and other bad actors know no bounds when it comes to bilking Pennsylvanians out of their hard-earned money. This conduct sounds callous and cold, but it happens, so be alert." According to the Office of the Attorney General, some signs of a scam include wanting to leave the dating app for a different messaging service, making excuses not to video chat, and inconsistencies in their story or history.
