

FINDINGS

The Federal Aviation Administration has released the agency's preliminary report detailing the unfortunate plane crash that took place in Lancaster County over the weekend. Of note, the report listed the crash as an accident and listed the highest injury from the incident as minor. Prior to the crash the report notes that the pilot was in communication with air traffic control about the plane's door being open.

NOT CLEARED TO LAND

A civilian aircraft was spotted Sunday flying in restricted airspace above President **Donald Trump's** Florida home. Air Force fighter jets deployed flares and intercepted the aircraft, which was then "escorted out" of the area. This incident was just one of more than twenty since the President took office in January. NORAD blames the incidents on civilian pilots not properly checking for restricted airspace before takeoff.

LUCK OF THE IRISH

Free Uber vouchers are returning to Harrisburg-area residents through the Sober Ride Home program. The initiative, which paused after New Year's due to funding issues, will offer \$15 vouchers for rides on Friday and Saturday nights, from 9 p.m. to 3 a.m. Eligible rides must begin in Cumberland, Dauphin, or Perry County but can end at any residential address.

WE ARE... WEST SHORE HOME FIELD

Yesterday, the Penn State Board of Trustees approved the naming rights at Beaver Stadium. Starting this season through 2039, Beaver Stadium will now be called "West Shore Home Field at Beaver Stadium" to honor a \$50 million gift from West Shore Homes. Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics **Pat Kraft** noted the change is to help pay for the \$700 million in proposed renovations. The stadium is named after **James Beaver**, the former acting President of the University and the 20th Governor of PA. The motion passed by a vote of 22-8, with the most vocal opposition coming from **Anthony Lubrano**, **Matt McGloin**, and **Jay Paterno**, who all noted that they should have considered naming the stadium after the late **Joe Paterno**.

BIRDS AT THE PEOPLE'S HOUSE

The Philadelphia Eagles will visit the White House to celebrate their Super Bowl victory, a team spokesperson confirmed Monday. The organization is currently working on scheduling the visit and finalizing logistics. This comes after false reports claimed the team would decline the invitation. In 2018, the Eagles were disinvited by the Trump Administration after most players opted not to attend.
