TAKE A HIKE

Several Pennsylvania campgrounds and beaches will close indefinitely in 2025 due to staffing shortages, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced. The agency cited safety concerns as the primary reason, emphasizing that essential operations like flood protection and emergency response will remain a priority. Impacted sites include Raystown Lake, Tioga-Hammond, and Cowanesque Lakes. Amid these closures, PA DCNR encourages the public to explore other state parks and forests which are open and ready for visitors.

I'M NOT LEAVING

U.S. Senate Democratic Leader *Chuck Schumer* has reiterated that he will not be resigning his position after voting in favor of the recently passed spending bill which ensured no government shutdown. Schumer has received significant pushback following his decision from fellow Democrats, which even led to him postponing his book tour. On his decision, Schumer stated, "I did it out of pure conviction as to what a leader should do and what the right thing for America and my party was."

LIVING RENT FREE

Canadian Prime Minster *Mark Carney* launched his campaign for Canada's April 28 snap election, vowing to defend the country's sovereignty against President *Donald Trump's* trade war and annexation threats. Trump's aggressive stance toward Canada has unexpectedly boosted Liberal poll numbers, shifting the election focus from economic

concerns to national identity. Conservative leader *Pierre Poilievre* once favored to win, now faces scrutiny over his perceived alignment with Trump despite insisting he will stand up to him.
