DENIED

In a 5-4 emergency ruling, the U.S. Supreme Court declined to halt a lower court's decision requiring the Trump Administration to release nearly \$2 billion in foreign aid payments. This marks the first time President Trump's efforts to reshape federal spending have reached the high court. Chief Justice *John Roberts* and Justice *Amy Coney Barrett* sided with the court's liberal justices against the Administration, while conservatives, including Justices Alito, Thomas, Gorsuch, and Kavanaugh, dissented. The ruling upholds a lower court order demanding the Administration comply with pre-existing USAID contracts and grants.

NEW RECRUITMENT STRATEGY

Governor **Josh Shapiro** is urging federal workers to apply for state positions, aiming to recruit the country's top talent as federal layoffs continue. As part of his initiative, Shapiro signed an executive order recognizing federal work experience on par with state work experience. He made the announcement at the Commonwealth Job Fair, encouraging those with federal experience to visit **PA.Gov/FedWorkers** for opportunities in roles like accountants, nurse aides, custodial workers, and PennDOT CDL operators.

JOB GARNISHING

The Internal Revenue Service continues to find its massive 90,000 workforce compliment under the microscope from the Department of Government Efficiency with the recent announcement that there are plans to potentially cut the agency by half. This news follows the recent announcement that approximately 7,000 probationary employees within the IRS have already been let go. The recent plan to shrink the agency is reported to include additional layoffs, attrition, and buyouts.

TEXAS SIZED LOSS

Democratic Congressman **Sylvester Turner** (TX) passed away yesterday at the age of 70. He had only served in the U.S. Congress for two months. Before serving in Congress, Turner was the Mayor of Houston for eight years and served in the Texas State House for twenty-seven years. On his passing, Minority Leader **Hakeem Jeffries** stated, "The House Democratic Caucus family is shocked and saddened by the sudden passing of Congressman Sylvester Turner. Though he was newly elected to the Congress, Rep. Turner had a long and distinguished career in public service and spent decades fighting for the people of Houston."
