CELEBRATION

Yesterday, a delayed annual Easter egg hunt took place at the Governor's Residence. Governor *Josh Shapiro*, Lt. Governor *Austin Davis*, and the First and Second Ladies hosted pre-school aged children at the event. This comes a little after a week after an arsonist set fire to the residence. While the burned section was roped off, kids enjoyed games, crafts, and animals on the Residence lawn.

DEFAULT

On Monday, the U.S. Department of Education announced that it would restart collecting federal student loans in default beginning on May 5th. According to the Department, more than 5 million borrowers are in default. If borrowers do not set up a payment plan or loan rehabilitation process, the DOE will begin garnishing wages this summer. In an effort to end the Biden Administration's SAVE plan, borrowers will no longer be able to set up income-driven payment plans. Instead, they will have to sign up for a new "enhanced" process.

ROGUE ONE

Harrisburg Mayor *Wanda Williams* announced she will run as an independent in the November general election if she loses the Democratic primary on May 20th. Williams revealed her plans during last night's abc27 Mayoral Debate, citing her previous success in a similar situation in 2021. She is currently facing four challengers in the crowded primary

race. The general election is set for November 4th.
