SLOW DOWN

The Pennsylvania Turnpike has kicked off its 10th annual "Go Orange" campaign, urging drivers to slow down and stay alert in highway work zones. Since 1940, more than 40 Turnpike workers have died on the job, prompting continued efforts to protect both workers and motorists. Key initiatives include speed safety cameras, educational programs for new drivers, and creative enforcement strategies like Operation Orange Squeeze. A traveling memorial honoring fallen workers will be displayed across Pennsylvania this summer to reinforce the campaign's life-saving message.

IT'S IN OUR DNA

The PA State Police has announced that it will now be utilizing a Rapid DNA program across the Commonwealth to improve the timing to process DNA samples. PSP deployed 15 fully automated genetic analyzers throughout the state, which will now enable DNA results to be delivered in 90 minutes. PSP also noted that Forensic Service Unit members, who must complete the required training, will be authorized to operate the new analyzers. On the new technology, Colonel *Christopher Paris* stated, "Rapid DNA analysis can expedite the development of investigative leads, assist in suspect identification, and help exclude individuals with greater speed. Aside from investigative efficiency, this technology provides accuracy, fairness, and better outcomes for the communities we serve."
