STRIKE DOWN

New Jersey Transit Union workers went on strike over the weekend after failing to agree on the terms of a new contract. But late last evening, the workers and the state reached a deal. Workers and rail services will return on Tuesday. Governor **Phil Murphy** called the deal "a good outcome," noting this fight over the contract had been brewing since the pandemic.

BROOKLYN BRIDGE IS DOWN

Saturday night, a training ship for the Mexican Navy hit the historic Brooklyn Bridge. The boat was without power and the current swept it to the bridge. Without a way to stop it, the top of the boat hit the bottom of the bridge. The Mexican Navy reported that 22 people were injured, 19 of those taken to the hospital. Two people have been confirmed dead.

BATTLE OF PA

This weekend, the Pittsburgh Pirates faced the Philadelphia Phillies in a three-game series. On Friday, the game was delayed due to the weather and ended in an 8-4 Phillies win. On Saturday, the Phillies handled the Pirates with ease in a 5-2 win. On Sunday, Pirates stud **Paul Skenes** faced off against **Mick Abel** in his rookie debut. Abel pitched six innings, and the Pirates won 1-0. The teams face off again June 6-8 in Pittsburgh.
