CLOUD NINE

Amazon announced plans to invest at least \$20 billion in data centers across Pennsylvania, marking the largest capital investment in the state's history. The first sites will be in Luzerne and Bucks Counties, with more to follow, creating an estimated 1,250 jobs and supporting AI and cloud computing infrastructure. While the move is praised for its economic potential, it has raised concerns over environmental impact, tax breaks, and significant demand of energy. Amazon also launched a \$250,000 community fund and pledged workforce training programs to support the initiative.

TRANSFER-MATION

PASSHE is picking up the tuition tab for 29 standout community college students. Selected by their colleges, the students will continue their education, free of charge, at one of PASSHE's 10 public universities. Since 2010, over 55,000 students have made the jump from community college to the PA State System. Most students go into high-demand fields

such as education, healthcare, and business.

WE ARE...IMPROVING

Penn State University has settled a lawsuit with *Spotlight PA*, agreeing to major transparency reforms after being accused of violating Pennsylvania's Sunshine Act by holding private meetings. As part of the settlement, the university's Board of Trustees will undergo mandatory open meetings law training, provide clearer public disclosures about nonpublic meetings, and post agendas for executive committee meetings. The agreement will remain enforceable for 5 years.
