EVANS EXITS

Afternearly five decades in office, Congressman **Dwight Evans** of Philadelphia has announced he won't run for re-election in 2026. The 71-year-old Democrat, who began serving in Pennsylvania's General Assembly in 1981 and joined Congress in 2016, said he made the decision following weekend discussions and personal reflection. Calling it the "honor of his life," he will finish out his term, which ends January 3, 2027.

NO DEAL

Pennsylvania's lawmakers have once again missed the July 1 deadline, leaving some payments in limbo as closed-door negotiations continue. Some bipartisan leaders feel they are close to a deal, even as key issues like rising Medicaid costs and taxing "skill" games remain unresolved. Despite the stalemate, essential payments and services like Medicaid, prisons, and state police will continue.
