#### **JOBS ON THE LINE**

President Trump's proposal to deport four million immigrants over the next four years could wipe out nearly six million jobs nationwide, including 115,000 in Pennsylvania, according to a new Economic Policy Institute analysis. These cuts would not just affect immigrants, as 50,000 U.S.-born Pennsylvanians could possibly lose work. The construction sector is expected to take the biggest hit, with 20,000 jobs vanishing in PA alone. Researchers warn that deportations shrink the workforce so abruptly that businesses may shut down altogether, harming both job supply and local economies.

### **STEEL CITY SCHEMER**

A Pittsburgh man faces over 200 felony charges for orchestrating a large-scale identity theft scheme to make fraudulent online purchases from Lowe's and Giant Eagle. *Cornelius P. Tucker* is accused of using stolen identities to acquire over \$100,000 worth of merchandise, including power tools, and security equipment, which he resold at discounted prices through his Facebook page, "Pittsburgh Stamps". The Attorney General credited the arrest to a detailed investigation by the Organized Retail Crime Unit and its partners, and Tucker was finally taken into custody on July 3.

### **GETTYSBURG HAS ENOUGH GHOSTS**

The infamous *Annabelle* doll will be making its way to Gettysburg this weekend as part of its tour across the country. The stop will be at the Soldiers Orphanage Homestead, a location known for paranormal activity. This controversial tour has been making its rounds across the country, which has upset some people who believe it should stay in its original box and home.

## **BANK ON IT**

Norwood Financial Corp. of Honesdale and PB Bankshares, Inc. of Coatesville announced plans to merge, expanding their reach across Central and Southeastern Pennsylvania. PB Bankshares will fold into Norwood Financial, the parent of Wayne Bank, boosting combined assets to roughly \$3 billion. The deal promises a broader product mix and stronger service for Presence Bank customers. With regulatory approvals pending, the merger is expected to close by late 2025 or early 2026, blending nearly 106 years of Presence's tradition with Wayne Bank's resources.

## PEDAL THE PAST

Looking for some weekend fun? Head to York County, where American Rail Bike Adventures offers a unique way to explore old railway lines. Located in Seven Valleys and Stewartstown, the experience lets visitors ride two and four-seat bikes directly on the tracks. The route includes scenic countryside and even the historic Howard Tunnel, built in 1840 and once used by *Abraham Lincoln's* funeral train. The bikes are partly handbuilt and open to riders of most ages and abilities. It's a blend of outdoor activity, history, and adventure!
