LAWMAKERS WANT CLASSROOMS ON MUTE

Three Pennsylvania State Senators plan to introduce a bill that would ban phone use during the school day to improve student mental health and academic focus. Citing research linking early smartphone access to issues like aggression and emotional instability, they argue that constant device use disrupts learning and classroom order. The bill would allow exceptions for students with medical needs or individualized education plans. If passed, Pennsylvania would join over two dozen states with similar restrictions. The proposal follows recent local moves, including new phone bans in the Carlisle and Harrisburg school districts.
