A memo circulated by State Representative **Joe McAndrew** urges Congress to pass legislation requiring states to observe Daylight Saving Time year-round and eliminate the seasonal time switch. Scranton Mayor *Paige Cognetti* stated she is "seriously considering" a run for the 8th Congressional District next year against Congressman *Rob Bresnahan*. She told reporters that she would make her decision in the next few weeks. Regarding her potential bid, she said, "What's happening to the most vulnerable in our community is despicable." Cognetti won her bid for mayor in 2020 during a special election.

THROWING OUT THE BREAD

Federal prosecutors failed to secure a felony indictment against former U.S. Justice Department employee **Sean Charles Dunn** who is accused of throwing a sandwich at a Customs and Border Projection agent. Dunn was fired from the DOJ after footage of him throwing the sandwich at the agent went viral. It is unclear whether prosecutors will try again to get an indictment or refile the case as a misdemeanor.

A CENTURY ON STAGE

The historic Strand Theater in downtown York marked its 100th anniversary yesterday.

First opened in 1925, the theater was nearly lost before a 1978 community campaign raised more than \$1 million to restore it, reopening with a gala featuring *Ella Fitzgerald* and the York Symphony Orchestra. Today, operated by the Appell Center, the Strand continues to host national artists and Broadway tours while serving as a cornerstone of York's arts scene.
