EXPLOSIVE DEVICES

Residents in Mill Creek Township (Lebanon County) were evacuated yesterday after police discovered explosive devices on Central Drive. Pennsylvania State Police and local officers cleared nearby homes, while a temporary shelter was set up in Newmanstown. The evacuation order was lifted by mid afternoon, though it remains unclear how the devices were found or what they contained.

ATTACK ON QATAR

Israeli forces carried out a strike against Hamas leaders in Doha, Qatar. This comes as a sharp escalation in tactics compared to previous strikes against Hamas as Qatar is a U.S. ally in the region and a mediator in resolving the war in Gaza. Hamas says that five of its members were killed but its leaders survived the attack. Qatari officials say that one member of its security forces was killed.

FAN OUT OF BOUNDS

A Buffalo Bills fan has been indefinitely banned from all NFL stadiums after shoving **DeAndre Hopkins** and **Lamar Jackson** during a touchdown celebration Sunday night. The incident, caught on camera, led to the fan's ejection. Jackson admitted he let his emotions get the best of him but hopes "it doesn't happen again."
