NEVER TO BE FORGOTTEN

What began 19 years ago with 12 motorcyclists stopping at a small chapel has grown into tradition of more than 100 riders who return each year to honor the 40 passengers and crew of Flight 93. Today, Flight 93 National Memorial marks the 24th observance of September 11th with a reading of names, the ringing of remembrance bells, and ceremonies attended by families, officials, and the public. Preparations are already underway for the 25th anniversary next year, which will include expanded programs and a traditional ceremony.

TURNING POINT UTAH

Charlie Kirk, conservative political activist and co-founder of Turning Point USA, was assassinated yesterday after being shot at an event at Utah Valley University. Kirk had been at the University for his outdoor "Prove Me Wrong" debate which was attended by thousands of college students. The suspect has yet to be found.

HERE COMES THE HURRIKANE

Former Attorney General of Pennsylvania *Kathleen Kane* will be hosting a podcast called "Through the HurriKANE" which will "teach you...the power of love and resistance" according to a recorded preview. She was the first Democrat and first woman to be elected Attorney General in the state of Pennsylvania in 2012. Kane resigned in 2016 after being convicted of perjury for leaking confidential information. The podcast will launch next

IT'S INFECTIOUS

The Pennsylvania Game Commission is investigating the spread of epizootic hemorrhagic disease (EHD), a viral illness that can be fatal to white-tailed deer, in northwestern Pennsylvania. The disease is spread from bites from infected midges. Deer with EHD typically show symptoms of swelling of the face or neck, loss of appetite, lethargy, lameness, respiratory distress, fever, and excessive salivation. There is currently no cure for EHD, but deer populations tend to recover two to three years after an outbreak.

REBUILD ON THE HORIZON

Harrisburg officials say construction on the fire-damaged Broad Street market brick building will now begin September 30, moving up from the previously announced October 30 start date. Mayor *Wanda Williams* approved the final design, which preserves the historic structure while adding HVAC, ADA compliance, and a mezzanine. The project will be funded through insurance, federal CDBG funds, and grants. The market has been closed since the July 2023 fire.
