Hersheypark is adding a new haunted house to its Dark Nights lineup this fall: Kill 'N Fill Garage. APPROVED

The PA Public Utility Commission yesterday approved a joint settlement filed by Verizon and Frontier allowing Verizon to acquire Frontier. The settlement, which was unanimously approved by the Commission, was supported by the PA Office of Consumer Advocate, Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Broad Horizons Lot Owners' Association. While the acquisition was approved by the Commonwealth, it is not final until both New York and California weigh in on the matter.
