SAYING THANKS

The bill was authored by State Senator *Kristin Phillips-Hill*, initially honoring veterans, and was expanded in the House through an amendment from State Representative *Dave Maloney* to also recognize first responders. DROP-OUT

Current New York City Mayor, *Eric Adams*, announced yesterday that he dropped out of the race for reelection by suspending his campaign. Several weeks ago, speculation arose around Adams dropping out of the race to help boost *Andrew Cuomo's* chances in November. Since Adams waited until now, his name will still appear on the ballot. Adams was elected as mayor in 2021 as a Democrat but decided to run as an Independent this cycle. He was indicted on federal charges in 2024 for bribery and campaign finance violations.
