Yesterday, Governor *Josh Shapiro* approved SEPTA's request to utilize capital projects funds for operations in attempt to ensure the transit system can reverse its proposed route reductions and cuts. SEPTA will continue to issue its fare increase that will take effect this weekend. SEPTA will be using \$394 million in capital funding for operational uses.

Dauphin County Commissioner **Justin Douglas** has announced he will be running for the 10th Congressional District in PA, going up against party favorite **Janelle Stelson** in the May Democratic primary. **Janelle Stelson** was the closest to beating current Congressman **Scott Perry** (R) in his tenure, coming in around 5,000 votes short last November. Stelson already has the support from Governor **Josh Shapiro**, State Senator **Patty Kim**, and State Representatives **Justin Fleming**, **Dave Madsen**, and **Nate Davidson** for this race.
