Travelers at Harrisburg International Airport got an unexpected broadcast Tuesday, when alleged Turkish hackers broke into the airport's PA system. The message, laced with political slogans, profanity, and references to global leaders, prompted police to investigate. Officials say that there were no threats to passengers or flights, and operations quickly returned to normal after the system was shut down.

Hosted by Midtown Scholar Books, the event runs through Sunday with more than 30,000 books on sale and a full lineup of author talks, children's activities, and cafe treats.

Dozens gathered in Harrisburg yesterday to mark White Cane Day, honoring the independence and mobility of people who are blind or visually impaired. The walk stretched from the Labor and Industry Building to the State Capitol, reminding drivers to slow down and stay alert for pedestrians using canes or guide dogs. Organizers say the event also celebrates Pennsylvania's distinction as the first state to require drivers to yield to blind pedestrians.


TWO WEEKS' NOTICE
