STAMPED OUT STATUS

The U.S. passport has lost some of its shine. According to the latest Henley Passport Index, America has slipped to 12th place, falling out of the World's Top 10 for the first time in years. Travelers with U.S. passports can now visit 180 destinations visa-free, fewer than Singapore, which tops the list with access to 193. Experts say shifting foreign policies and reduced visa agreements are behind the decline, marking a change in America's global mobility and influence.

ACCELERATED TALKS

President **Donald Trump** said he plans to speak with Russian President**Vladimir Putin** about ending the war in Ukraine. The announcement came after news broke of a meeting today between Trump and Ukrainian President **Volodymyr Zelenskyy** for negotiating the sale of U.S. Tomahawk cruise missiles to Ukraine. Putin has previously stated that such a sale would jeopardize relations between the U.S. and Russia.

Being one of 110 bands selected for the competition, this Luzerne County school band has the honor of performing on the national stage in Indianapolis.
