Amazon Web Services (AWS) went down yesterday, causing countless businesses to go without internet access for hours. The outage began when AWS' database service, DynamoDB, made an update that included error information which caused the system to crash and go offline. Amazon has since been able to get DynamoDB up and running for businesses and consumers across the East Coast.

J.M. Smucker, the company behind Smucker's Uncrustables, is suing Trader Joe's over what they allege to be a copycat PB&J sandwich with no crust. The lawsuit claims that Trader Joe's infringed on trademarks of Smucker's sandwiches with their pie-like shape and crimped edges. This is not the only lawsuit between companies and supermarkets over copyrighted labels on products. Mondelez, makers of Oreos, Wheat Thins, and Ritz Crackers; sued Aldi earlier in May over selling products that look strikingly similar to what they produce in terms of packaging and the product itself.


CELEBRATION
