DRUG BUSTERS

So far over the course of this year, 50 million doses of fentanyl were seized in raids across the state. At a press conference earlier this week, Pennsylvania Attorney General *Dave Sunday* said 27 million of those doses were recovered in and around Philadelphia. This is part of a larger movement from the federal government to crack down on the illicit drug trade in the U.S.
