ANNOUNCED

Public school teacher **Jen Mazzocco** announced that she will be running in House District 42 to replace State Representative **Dan Miller**. Miller won his bid to serve as a judge in Allegheny County in the most recent General Election. Mazzocco is joined by **Alliyson Feldmann**, a grassroots political activist, in the field of Democrats looking to replace Miller. No date has been set for the special election.

CANCER STUDY

A new study from Penn State finds that adults over the age of 50 throughout 15 counties across Central and South Central Pennsylvania are 57% more likely to develop melanoma compared to people in the rest of the state. The study suggests that there is a correlation between being in areas with high levels of agricultural activity or herbicide use and the odds of developing this deadly form of skin cancer. Researchers from Penn State claim that the results are cause for awareness over fear as more research is needed to solidify these results.

POLITICAL THREAT SURGE

Two Pennsylvania lawmakers received bomb threats at their district offices on Friday, just a day after President *Donald Trump* accused them and four other Democratic veterans of "sedition." U.S. Representatives *Chrissy Houlahan* and *Chris Deluzio* reported that their teams were safely evacuated, with local law enforcement investigating. The threats were after a video in which the lawmakers urged military and intelligence officials to reject unlawful orders, prompting Trump's online attacks.

GREENER PASTURES

U.S. Representative *Marjorie Taylor Greene* recently announced her resignation from Congress with her last day in office being January 5th, 2026. This comes as President *Donald Trump* called her a traitor on Truth Social over her signing of a discharge petition to force a vote on releasing the Epstein files. It is uncertain whether Greene's political ambitions end here or if she is planning to seek public office in the future.
