PA'S GEN Z POLITICIANS

Starting this month, Pennsylvania's newly elected officials are beginning their terms, some of which are from a younger generation. Four Generation Z (1997-2012) Mayors have been elected in the Commonwealth, including Carnegie Mayor **Sam Bigham**, Darby Mayor **Joar Dahn**, Westover Mayor **Dylan Stevens**, and Cleona Mayor **Matt Zechman**. The Gen Z Mayors represent both ends of the ideological spectrum. In Pennsylvania, the average age for an elected official is 61.
