LAST TERM

Yesterday, State Representative **Sheryl Delozier** announced that she will not run for re-election this year. Delozier is currently serving her 9th term in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives. She expressed that the decision came about after discussions with loved ones and reiterated that her dropping is not due to fear of competition.

WAKE UP

Pennsylvania lawmakers will soon be introducing legislation that could enhance young people's lives, a later start time for secondary schools. The bipartisan memo, circulated by State Representatives **Jill Cooper** and **Tim Briggs**, specifically cites a study from the Joint State Government Commission, which recommended secondary schools begin at 8:30 a.m. at the earliest. There has been concern around the Commonwealth and beyond about kids getting enough sleep, and many believe a later start time could enhance schooling and physical performance. AVENUE OF THE ARTS

This morning is the groundbreaking of the new project for the Avenue of the Arts on Broad Street in Philadelphia. This first phase (Spruce and Pine Streets) of the project will begin construction at the end of January and is currently scheduled to be completed by June. This project is supported by local, state, and federal officials who have come together to make Philadelphia even better!

CLINTON'S IN CONTEMPT?

U.S. House Republicans are moving forward with contempt of Congress proceedings against former President **Bill Clinton**. This comes after he failed to appear for a deposition, that had already been pushed back once before, in the House Oversight Committee's investigation of **Jeffery Epstein**. Committee Chairman **James Comer** threatened similar action against Former Secretary of State **Hillary Clinton** if she fails to appear to her scheduled deposition today. If the measure passes

STUCK IN THE MIDDLE
