THE FIGHT IS OVER

Harrisburg Mayor **Wanda Williams** and Harrisburg City Council have reached an agreement on the salaries of three members of the Mayor's staff. The ongoing dispute resulted in a lawsuit that was ultimately dismissed back in January. The Mayor claimed that the city council had cut funding to three positions that she needed on her staff. In addition to the salary agreement, both sides agreed the Mayor can no longer appoint interim directors of departments, the positions that were in question.

BRINGING HOME THE BACON

U.S. Senator **John Fetterman** (D – PA) announced he has successfully secured nearly \$300 million in Congressionally Directed Spending for the Commonwealth. The funding will go towards 121 various projects across PA for initiatives such as water infrastructure upgrades, affordable housing, and equipment for police departments. On the funding, Fetterman stated, “Bringing money back to PA is one of my core responsibilities as the senior senator. The Pennsylvania Turnpike is celebrating one full year of using the Open Road Tolling System (ORT). ORT is a system where drivers are charged electronically as they drive through the Turnpike, allowing them to maintain highway speeds without slowing or stopping. As they celebrate a full successful year, the PA Turnpike has announced they will continue to expand the ORT system. Specifically, the hope is to modernize western PA toll plazas in 2027.
