HEADS UP HERNANDO

In anticipation of Winter Storm Hernando, Governor Shapiro signed a proclamation of disaster emergency for the Commonwealth. The disaster emergency, which took effect immediately on Sunday, allows state agencies and officials to respond quicker to the storm's impact. While not expected, disaster declarations cannot be in effect for any longer than 21 days unless it is approved by the General Assembly. The declaration still allows individuals to travel and business to open with no restrictions. Due to the storm, the Budget Hearings in both the House and Senate today have been postponed.

This weekend, Penn State University participated in its annual THON, the largest student-run philanthropy in the world. THON raises money to help find a cure for childhood cancer through Four Diamonds and has been a tradition at PSU since 1977. With over 700 students participating in this year's 46-hour dance-a-thon, the students set a new record for donations. At around 1:30am Sunday, an armed man attempted to enter the perimeter of Mar-a-Lago and was shot and killed. The 21-year-old, **Austin Tucker Martin**, drove inside the gate while another car was leaving. He had a gas can and shotgun on him. When authorities told him to drop his weapons, he dropped the gas can but put the shotgun into firing position, at which point the Secret Service shot him. There is no motive determined yet. President **Donald Trump** and the First Lady were at the White House at the time.
