## LATTER DAYS

Over the weekend the United States and Israeli militaries conducted a joint operation against the Islamic Republic of Iran, executing a successful decapitation strike on *Ayatollah Khomeini* and much of his leadership team. In response, Iran shot missiles back at U.S. military installations, Israel, all six of its Gulf state neighbors, and is attempting to blockade the Strait of Hormuz through which 20% of the world's oil is shipped.

## TARIFFS

Though the Supreme Court decided that the tariffs were unlawful, small businesses are still struggling to make gains.
