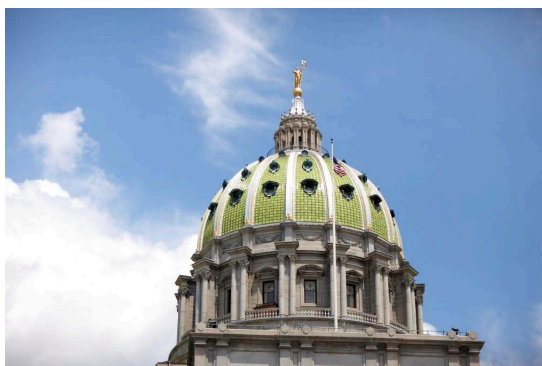

## SIZE MATTERS

The PA Fish and Boat Commission voted to propose legislation that will increase the minimum size limit for harvesting trout. The legislation will increase the limit from seven to nine inches. This change is intended to protect the Commonwealth's trout population. If passed, the legislation would go into effect on January 1st.
