TRAVELIN BAND

Ticket holders for a canceled Harrisburg Midtown Arts Center (HMAC) show are now eligible for refunds, according to state Attorney General **Dave Sunday**. After HMAC's closure in February, the venue refused to issue refunds and customers reported failed credit card disputes. To resolve the issue, the Office of the Attorney General worked with EventIM, which agreed to process HMAC refunds. Customers seeking a refund should email help@seetickets.us with the date of the purchased show and their order number.

WHO'LL STOP THE RAIN

U.S. and Iranian negotiators reached a preliminary agreement to end the war that has been ongoing since February. The deal includes a ceasefire, reopening the Strait of Hormuz, and establishes a 60-day negotiation period to address nuclear weaponry and sanctions. President **Donald Trump** and Pakistani Prime Minister **Shehbaz Sharif** praised the agreement, though additional negotiations and details remain unresolved.

The Pride of Susquehanna has returned and it's better than ever! After its two-year hiatus, the 'Pride' riverboat gives guests a unique way to experience Harrisburg in the hot summer months. The season launches July 10 with a boat party featuring Brewery Tours, where guests can sip their favorite brews from a collectible souvenir glass. Following the kickoff, fan favorites return,

including the family-friendly Princess Fairy Cruise and the interactive Murder and Mayhem dining cruises.

MIDNIGHT SPECIAL

The rest of June will see some big names make concert stops at Hersheypark Stadium. Singer **Forrest Frank** will take the stage tonight, June 15th, after his show planned for yesterday was rescheduled due to weather. On June 20th, folk rock band **Mumford & Sons** will perform here, and they might perform "Here," their new song featuring country star **Chris Stapleton**. Stapleton himself will perform four nights later on June 24th, continuing a tour that he began in 2017. Finally, on June 26th, legendary guitarist **Carlos Santana** and his band will perform alongside **The Doobie Brothers**.

PROUD MARY

The New York Knicks are champions once again. After 53 years of title drought, the Knicks won the NBA Finals over the San Antonio Spurs on Saturday. They were led by their star player, **Jalen Brunson**, who scored 45 points on the night, a monster performance on the biggest stage. Also emerging victorious this weekend was the Carolina Hurricanes, who won the NHL's Stanley Cup Final over the Vegas Golden Knights. The last time the Hurricanes were crowned champions, which was in 2006, current Head Coach **Rod Brind'Amour** was the Captain for Carolina.
