GAME OF LUCK

The Pennsylvania Supreme Court announced their ruling yesterday that skill game machines are illegal. The decision provides 120 days before enforcement begins, time that state legislators and Governor Shapiro could decide what to do about the devices. This could become a critical piece in resolving this year's budget. Attorney General **Dave Sunday** said on this decision, "The Supreme Court recognized what our office has argued from the beginning – these machines operate as gambling devices and cannot legally exist without the same oversight, regulation and accountability as other forms of legalized gaming in the Commonwealth."

READY, SET, BID

The Pennsylvania Department of General Services' Bureau of Vehicle Management has announced that at this June's Commonwealth Vehicle Auction, 275 used vehicles will be available for public purchase. The **lineup** includes retired state police cruisers, SUVs, utility vehicles, sedans, minivans, and even vehicles seized by law enforcement agencies. The auction takes place today, June 16 at 10:00 AM at Manheim Keystone Pennsylvania, located at 488 Firehouse Road in Grantville. Buyers must be prepared to pay with cash, a money order, or a cashier's/certified check made payable to "Cox's Automotive."

QUARANTINE ORDER

Pennsylvania farmers and pet owners have been advised to take precautionary measures after a screwworm was found in Texas earlier this month. The quarantine order, announced by

Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture Secretary **Russell Redding**, requires animals entering the state to undergo health inspections to prevent the life-threatening pest from spreading to the state. No screwworm cases have been reported in Pennsylvania thus far.
