LEGISLATORS TO BAT

The annual Capitol All-Stars Game is scheduled for next Monday at 5:30 PM at FNB Field on City Island, where Pennsylvania state legislators will compete in a friendly game of baseball to help fight hunger. The Yinz team, led by State Senate Minority Leader **Jay Costa** and State House Minority Leader **Jesse Topper**, has won the most games in the event's history and will take on the Youse team, led by Speaker of the House **Joanna McClinton** and State Senator **Greg Rothman**. **Tickets** are available for \$15, with proceeds supporting Feeding Pennsylvania and Hunger-Free Pennsylvania.

FISHY BUSINESS

The PA Fish and Boat Commission has reviewed updated state regulations affecting which fish anglers will be able to catch and keep. One part of the proposal would increase the minimum size for harvesting trout, from 7 inches to 9 inches. Most wild trout are under nine inches, but stocked trout generally exceed 11 inches, so this regulation would work to conserve the wild trout population. The Commission is also looking to conserve two native catfish species in the Ohio River Basin. Another regulation would mandate catch-and-release for blue catfish, while dictating a four-fish-limit for flathead catfish with additional protections for trophy-sized fish. The Commission will vote on these proposals and more on July 27th.

TIME CAPSULE

The United States has filled and sealed shut a 900-pound steel cylinder, which is to be buried in Philadelphia on July 4th, 2026, as a time capsule. It will be opened 250 years from now in the year 2276, which would be America's 500th anniversary. All 50 states, each of the territories and DC, and several America250 partners like the NFL, Coca-Cola, and the PGA Tour contributed to the time capsule. Pennsylvania's contribution to the time capsule includes a "Greetings from Harrisburg" letter from Governor Shapiro and a commemorative America250 booklet.

MUSIC MYSTERY

Harrisburg will be visited by state and local artists from Sofar Sounds, a collaborative group of musical performers, on July 25 and August 15. Sofar is known for hosting live music events in unique venues that are revealed just two days before each show, offering audiences a distinctive concert experience. The events will mark the company's debut in the city, with a Harrisburg chapter of Sofar Sounds launching soon.
