FIREWORKS

Yesterday the PA Senate adjourned for the week without a budget bill sent to the Governor's desk. The PA House will be in session today before adjourning to the call of the chair... likely next week. Republicans and Democrats issued public statements laying out their views on the situation. In short, this marks the fifth consecutive budget that has gone beyond the June 30 Constitutional guideline. Hope remains that a deal will be struck over the long holiday weekend and put into place early next week.

NO YOLK

Over 3.4 million eggs will be donated to Pennsylvania charitable food organizations following a settlement with three major egg companies. Yesterday's announcement by PA Attorney General **Dave Sunday** came after the conclusion of a broader investigation which found that Cal-Maine Foods, Versova, and Hickman's Egg Ranch collaborated to manipulate the egg price index, increasing costs for consumers in the United States. Under the agreement, the companies will donate over 53 million eggs nationwide.

HARRISBURG GOES INTERNATIONAL

A Harrisburg based soccer team, Journey FC, will represent the city in an international tournament in China this August. The World Affairs Council of Harrisburg has collaborated with DENO International, a China-based organization that facilitates international engagement, to help bring

global attention to Harrisburg through the event. Journey FC is made up of 18 players, recruited students from local high schools and universities, who are eager to play internationally.

To celebrate Independence Day, enjoy the following events in Harrisburg. The July 4 Food Truck Festival will take place from 1:00pm to 9:00pm in Riverfront Park with fireworks to follow at 9:15pm. The Declaration of Independence will be read aloud from the porch of John Harris-Simon Cameron Mansion at 10:00am and 1:00pm. Lower Paxton Township will host a celebratory family festival in the early afternoon on the 4th (10:00am to 1:00pm) and the evening on the 5th (4:00pm to 8:00pm) at the Dauphin County Heroes Grove. The Historical Society of Dauphin County will put on a Colonial Costume Ball starting at 5:00pm at the Peter Allen House.

HEATWAVE

The American Red Cross is urging Central Pennsylvania residents to prepare for a dangerous heat wave expected to build this week, warning the heat is not typical for the region. Officials say people should stay hydrated, find air-conditioned spaces, and check in on neighbors as temperatures rise. Most counties and cities will have cooling stations as needed.
