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HUNTING SEASON

Pennsylvania's elk hunters will see some major changes this fall, with the Pennsylvania Game Commission redrawing hunting zones for the first time in more than a decade. The regular rifle season will also be split into two periods – October 3-11 and October 31-November 8 – giving rifle hunters a new opportunity to hunt during the elk rut. The state is also adding 15 bull elk tags this season.

ACCREDITATION ACTION

The Trump Administration is moving to revoke the American Bar Association's (ABA) authority to accredit U.S. law schools. The U.S. Department of Education says the ABA is out of compliance with the federal accreditation standards, while ABA officials are preparing to defend its longstanding role as the national accreditor for legal education. The change could have major implications for law schools, prospective law students, and employers nationwide.

SLOW DOWN

Motorists in Mifflin and Juniata counties should be alert for the PA Department of Transportation and PA State Police's Operation Yellow Jacket effort currently underway. The effort is intended to raise awareness of the safety for PennDOT workers and promote safe driving practices in active work zones. Troop G Public Information Officer Trooper **Jake Rhymestine** stated, "Our goal is not to write tickets. Our goal is to prevent the violations that would warrant a ticket from happening in the first place." PennDOT has noted there were 1,393 work zone crashes last year that included 12 deaths and 805 injuries.

BRIDGE DOWN

Construction on the Interstate 83 John Harris Memorial Bridge will begin in January, according to PennDOT. PennDOT received federal funding to assist with the completion of the \$1.3 billion project. The plan is to build a new bridge just south of the old one, tear down the existing bridge, and build a new bridge where the old one is torn down. When completed, the two bridges will together be the northbound and southbound traffic of I-83. The entirety of the project is expected to take nearly 10 years.
