ON A STREAK

Pennsylvania Attorney General **Dave Sunday** announced yesterday that he is suing Snap Inc., the owner of the popular app Snapchat, for misleading parents and using features that keep children engaged with the platform. The lawsuit alleges that Snap violated the state's consumer protection law and is seeking penalties that would require the app to change its marketing to minors. Sunday quoted, "The lawsuit also demands that Snapchat finally come clean about the addictiveness of their app and takes real action to protect young users" while a spokesperson for Snap says this suit "fundamentally misrepresent our platform and our approach to teen safety." This suit against Snap comes just weeks after Sunday filed a similar lawsuit against TikTok.
