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NEVER FORGET

The Pennsylvania State Archives is opening a new exhibit commemorating the 25th anniversary of 9/11, featuring artifacts connected to Flight 93 and Pennsylvania's response to the attacks. The exhibit includes items from the National Park Service and Flight 93 Memorial, including pieces of aircraft wreckage, investigator badges, silverware and tributes from families and visitors. The exhibit will be on display in the East Wing Rotunda of the Capitol Complex through October 27.

AIMED TO PLEASE

The Pennsylvania Game Commission has announced that a new and improved HuntFishPA app will launch in 2027. This app will supply hunters and anglers with convenient ways to store their digital license, update their personal information, and scope out local hunting and fishing areas. As of now, hunters can still view their licenses online at the HuntFishPA website, but as the new app launches, the old application will be deactivated.

REED BETWEEN THE LINES

Harrisburg City Council is considering a proposal to lease space to inventory and preserve artifacts from the **Stephen Reed** era, while also discussing how to pay back \$2.3 million in costs from failed city park projects. The park funding issue stems from the city missing a deadline to complete grant-funded projects, leaving Harrisburg responsible for repaying the state. The city plans to have an online auction for the remaining items by the end of this year.

STEAMING ALONG

The Williams Grove Historical Steam Engine Association is bringing its 68th annual Steam Show to Monroe Township through September 6. The nine-day event features historic steam engines, tractors, a car show, a model railroad, a sawmill, tractor pulls, and more. This year's show also welcomes the Rockhill Trolley Museum, bringing an electric trolley to Cumberland County for the first time since 1938. Visitors can enjoy a ride on the fully electric trolley during the event.

REST IN POWER

The trailblazer for women's rights and passionate journalist **Gloria Steinem** passed away yesterday at the age of 92. Steinem is remembered for her advocacy in the 1960's, first coming to fame when she wrote an exposé about **Hugh Hefner** and the Playboy mansion. During her years of advocacy, she is remembered for her passion regarding reproductive rights, domestic violence prevention, helping women file for their own credit cards, and assisting women in admissions to Ivy Leagues. She achieved some of the highest honors possible, receiving the Presidential Medal of Freedom from Obama.
